Attendance

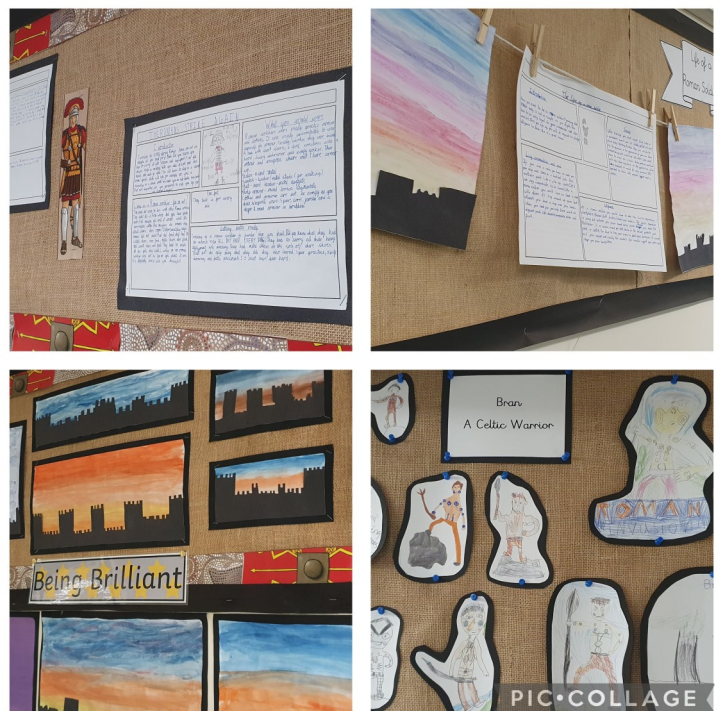
