

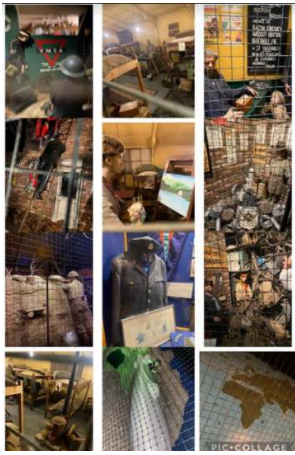


World War 2 Project

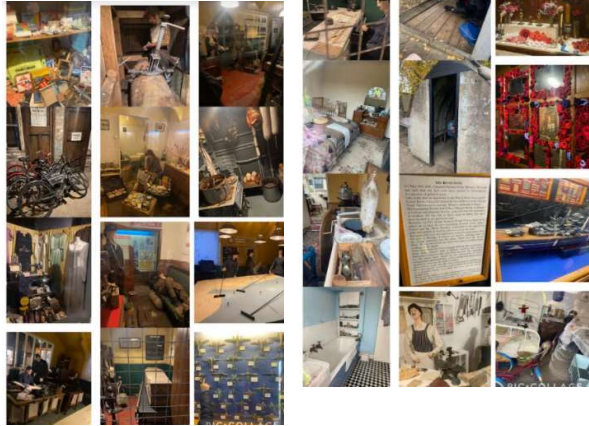

Take a look at what we've been up to in year 6!



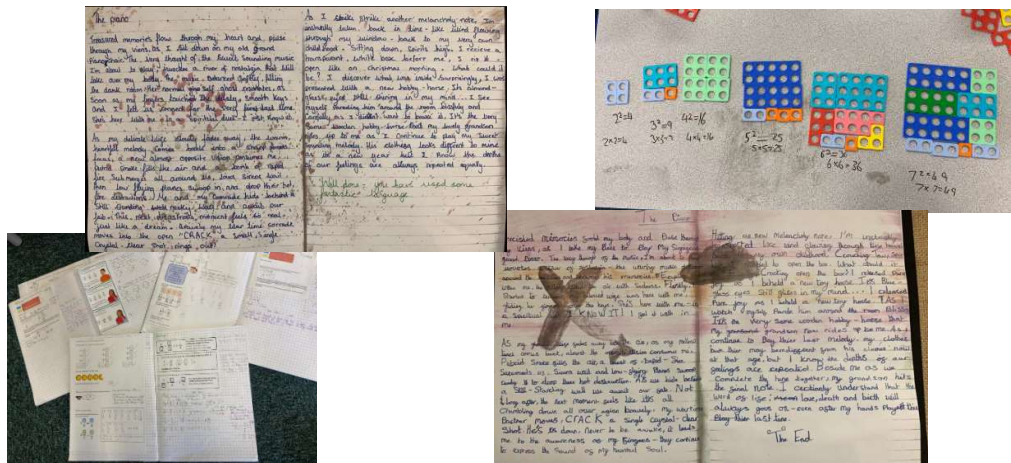
Our trip to Eden Camp.
