As Artists we will:

As Geographers we will...

Use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of their school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment

As Authors we will:

Use our trip to write a recount.

Write instructions on 'How to grow a cress head'.

Be introduced to suffixes such as 'ing', 'er', 'est' and 'ed'.

Continue to use conjunctions to extend our writing.

Write a narrative based on 'The Odd Egg' by Emily Gravett.

As Scientists we will...

Identify and name a variety of plants in their habitats.

Compare and describe the structure of common animals.

Name and compare a variety of common animals including mammals, birds, reptiles and amphibians and group them according to their features.

Identify and name a range of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

As Mathematicians we will:

Compare and order numbers within 50.

Consolidate counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and use this to solve problems.

Look at making equal groups and looking at their repeated addition problems.

Look for arrays in the environment and identify the equal groups within them.

Identify halves and quarters of shapes and number.

As Citizens we will...

Learn about dental care and the risks of eating too much sugar.

Learn about people who keeps us safe at school and the wider community and have a visit from a dentist and the fire and police service.

As Active bees we will...

Develop our bat and ball skills by playing cricket and tennis

Learn about the value of sportsmanship and the importance of 'being on the team.'
