### LaceyField SMSC Overview



At LaceyField, we are passionate about celebrating and embracing our differences. Below is an overview of picture books that address the protected characteristics in the Equality Act, teaching our children to have respect for diversity. This curriculum also prepares young people for life as global citizens and promotes community cohesion. The picture books chosen are closely linked with our 'bee-haviours for learning and life'.

#### What is SMSC?

SMSC stands for **spiritual**, **moral**, **social and cultural** development. All schools in England must show how well their pupils develop in SMSC.

#### <u>Spiritual</u>

Explore beliefs and experience; respect faiths, feelings and values; enjoy learning about oneself, others and the surrounding world; use imagination and creativity; reflect.

#### <u>Moral</u>

Recognise right and wrong; respect the law; understand consequences; investigate moral and ethical issues; offer reasoned views.

#### <u>Social</u>

Use a range of social skills; participate in the local community; appreciate diverse viewpoints; participate, volunteer and cooperate; resolve conflict; engage with the 'British values' of democracy, the rule of law, liberty, respect and tolerance.

#### **Cultural**

Appreciate cultural influences; appreciate the role of Britain's parliamentary system; participate in culture opportunities; understand, accept, respect and celebrate diversity.
