<p><b>Pirate</b> - a person who robs ships at sea.</p> <p><b>Plunder</b> - to steal something.</p> <p><b>Continent</b> - the main division of land.</p> <p><b>Ocean</b> - a large area of water between different continents.</p> <p><b>Capital City</b> - the city where the government is located.</p> <p><b>Port</b> - a town or city where ships can dock.</p> <p><b>Town</b> - a place where there are lots of streets and houses and people live and work.</p> <p><b>City</b> - a place where there are many houses and streets, people live and work and there is a cathedral.</p> <p><b>Village</b> - is a small area of houses and some shops.</p> <p><b>Shipwreck</b> - when a ship has been destroyed.</p>	<p>There are 7 continents in the world: Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Australia/Oceania and Antarctica.</p>	<p>There are 5 oceans in the world: Atlantic Ocean, Pacific Ocean, Indian Ocean, Arctic Ocean and Southern Ocean.</p>	<p>The United Kingdom is made up of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.</p>

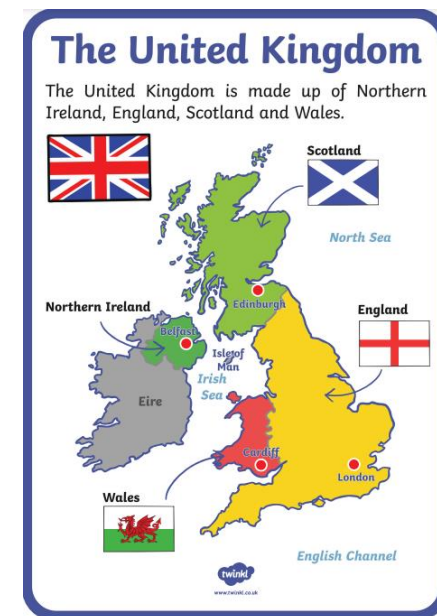
