What will we be learning?

As Historians, we will –

- Explain what an object from the past might have been used for.
- Explain how some parts of Louth have changed over time (Louth canal)
- Sequence 3 or 4 artefacts from distinctly different periods of times.
- Begin to distinguish between fact and fiction.
- Find out about the life of someone who used to live in my area using the internet or books.

As Geographers, we will –

- Name the capital city of England.
- Name the four countries in the United Kingdom and locate them on a map.
- Examine the flags and national symbols of the countries of the UK.
- Name some of the main towns and cities in the UK.
- Name human and physical features associated with mu town.
- Focus on warm climates.

As Scientists, we will –

- Observe and describe the weather associated with Summer.
- Identify and name a variety of common garden plants and recall deciduous and evergreen trees.
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants.
- Recall a variety of everyday materials and describe the simple physical properties.
- Identify and name a variety of common animals that live in warm climates.
- Perform simple tests.

As Artists, we will –

- Create different types of lines.
- Explore line and mark-making to draw water.
- Use materials and mark making to draw from observation.
- Plan and make imaginative sculpture.

As Musicians, we will –

- Explore rhythm and tempo through the themes of water, number, animals, storyline.

In PE, we will –

- Continue to develop our physical skills with the help of our sports coaches.
- Take part in activities and games which build teamwork.

In Computing, we will –

- Explore programming animations.
- Explore digital writing.

In RE, we will -

- Explore Judaism.
- Learn to empathise with Jewish children by understanding why Shabbat and Chanukah are important.

In PSHE, we will –

- Explore 'relationships'.
- Explore 'Changing me'.
