What will we be learning?

As Historians, we will learn about the achievements of the Mayans. We will find out where they were from, what their daily lives were like and why farming was so important to their civilisation.

As Geographers, we will be learning about the geography of the UK. We will locate different regions and counties using map skills and we will find out about land use in Lincolnshire. We will compare and contrast the environments of the UK and the Amazon Rainforest.

As Scientists, we will learn about plants, nutrition and the skeleton. We will name the parts of a plant and find out the jobs which they do. We will investigate what plants need to grow well and find out about the life cycle of flowering plants. We will learn about how to look after our bodies with a healthy diet and the effects of an unhealthy lifestyle. We will also learn about the function of different bones in the human body.

As Designers, we will design and make our own healthy food products. The children will be set the challenge to create a healthy bread product, to make lunch times more interesting. The children will then make and bake their own bread and fill it with delicious and nutritious ingredients.

As Artists, we will design packaging for our food products. We will also study botanical art. We will draw flowers using pencil, focusing on line and tone. We will also use paint and mixed media to explore colour.

As Musicians, we will compose word rhythms, sing in a round and use percussion instruments to keep a steady beat. We also have a fabulous opportunity to learn how to play a Djembe drum and perform a sequence of rhythms. We will focus on beat, rhythm and performance. This will be delivered by the Lincolnshire Music Service.

In PE, the children we will be developing their athletics skills through throwing, catching and jumping. In our lessons we'll use javelins, discus and shot puts, as well as stopwatches, measuring equipment and observation. We'll be learning how effective techniques can support us as we head towards Sports Days in June.

In Computing, we will be using Google Slides to present information. We will learn how to change fonts, import pictures and add different backgrounds to the slides.

In RE, we will learn about Sikhism. We will learn about their beliefs, lifestyle, gods/goddesses and compare with other faiths.

In PSHE, we are learning about relationships. We with learn about roles and responsibilities, being a good friend and a good global citizen.

In Languages, we will learn french words and songs for a range of celebrations.
